

JCSER was able to attain Israeli Ministry of Interior approval on eight Family Reunification applications after a long halt on processing those applications. According to the approvals the Ministry of Interior granted temporary residency to those families that are affected by the approvals.

The processing of the applications was halted after Israeli government decision dated May 12, 2002. The decision was then legally contested by JCSER and the Center attained a court ruling obliging the Ministry of Interior to process all Family Reunification applications
